

## Student Prize (2022) of the Swiss Ethnobiology Network

The Swiss Ethnobiology Network strives to encourage students in their early career and awards a yearly prize to support high quality project ideas in the field of ethnobiology.

## Eligibility criteria:

- The research project must essentially focus on an ethnobiology-related topic.
- The work must be linked to Switzerland (personally, institutionally, or thematically).
- The application must be in English or one of the Swiss national languages.

Applications will be evaluated by a panel of three experts. The winner of the prize will be informed by **31 December 2022** and the official result will be communicated at the annual symposium (usually in February or March), where applicants will be encouraged to present their work. The prize winner receives a certificate, a 3-year membership to the network and CHF 300.-. The network reserves its right not to award the prize.
